Type of Instrument	Equipment Requirements
Brass	Valve oil or slide cream and tutor book
Woodwind – Flutes	Tutor book and polishing cloth
Clarinets & Saxophones	Cork grease, reed saver and tutor book
String	Rosin, tutor book, polishing cloth, shoulder rest and music stand (highly recommended)
Percussion	Drumsticks (size 5A nylon or wooden tip) and tutor book (Alfred's Drum Method Book 1 ~ blue book)

Please note: Instrumental Levy should be paid in term 1 along with the Instrumental Hire Fee. (If applicable) An instrument that is hired to a student will be given out when the hire fee is paid with the levy.

Care and Maintenance of School Instruments

While school instruments are on loan to students it is expected that students will undertake responsibility for the care and safety of the instrument. While the school will carry out the usual schedule of ongoing maintenance, any damage to the instrument, which takes place during the course of the loan, will be deemed the student's responsibility, and such as the student's family will be responsible for the cost of the repairs.

Examinations and Assessment

All students participating in the Instrumental Music Program undergo formal assessment at the end of Semester One and Semester Two. Examinations are compulsory for all Instrumental students. The results of this testing is sent home on a separate report card with the school report card at the end of each semester.
